

Social inclusion

The Lombardy Region promotes programmes for social inclusion by funding district-based Social Laboratories, which are already active in the public housing districts of 33 municipalities in Lombardy.



The Social Laboratory

What is it?

The Social Laboratory is intended as a "proximity and local protection service" aimed at promoting social inclusion in districts characterised by marginality and social fragility.

The Social Laboratory is the operational centre in which aggregation and educational activities are developed; it is a place for listening to the residents of a given district and collecting reports.

In addition, the activities are offered by operators qualified to provide work services and training for the prevention and reduction of situations of temporary economic difficulty to the residents of the districts concerned.

What are the benefits?

Citizens living in the districts identified by the projects presented by the Municipalities can contact the Social Laboratory.

The Municipalities involve residents by offering training and work services and providing an allowance equal to the value of the services attended, up to a maximum of € 2,000.00.

What are the prerequisites?

The Lombardy Region provides a social inclusion programme (*PIP - Personalised Intervention Plan*) that aims at offering training and employment services.

The requirements to participate in the PIP are:

- **participating in the activities provided for in the Social Laboratories**
- **being in temporary economic difficulty and/or experiencing housing problems**

How to join

The call is addressed to Municipalities submitting social inclusion projects for residents of public housing districts. The edition involving the 33 Municipalities is closed and the projects will end in 2020.
